MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Dear Citizens of Smiley,

The City of Smiley called an election for Saturday, May 4, 2019 at the Smiley Volunteer Fire Department. There are three council seats up for grabs. Linda Warzecha and Elisa Douglas will be up for re-election and H. Wayne South did not sign up to run again. The City has a total of seven candidates who signed up (for list and ballot order see 2nd page). Come out and show your support and vote for the candidate of your choice. Make every vote count and help continue in our efforts to make improvements for our City.

The City Council approved for the Mayor and City Secretary to continue discussions and take action on Resolution #2019-02, authorizing the submission of an application for the 2019-2020 TxCDBG Community Development Fund.

The Mayor and City Secretary were designated as authorized signatures for Contractual and Grant Fund documents pertaining to Texas Community Block Grant program Contract # 7218459, Resolution 2019-04. (Water Meter Project and Storage Tank)

The city is also having further discussions with General Land Office (GLO) for the street improvements on Harvey-CDBG-DR. We will keep you inform with any future developments for the City.

All city questions and concerns should be addressed and/or brought to City Hall to be allocated to the proper department.

Republic Serves had a price increase of .44 cents in April and the Council decided to leave the City rate as is for now.

The City dumpster is open every first and third Saturday of the Month from 8-1 pm. First dump is free to customers in the city limits. There is a charge for out of the city limits customers. If you want to dump twice in one day, there will be an additional charge. Please pay at City Hall between the hours of 8-12 (noon) Monday-Friday.

Brush pickup is the First Friday of every Month.

City Hall is a "No Cash on Premises", please do not leave cash in drop box or come by city to make a payment with it. You will be asked to come back with a check or money order. The post office is open Monday – Saturday and can help you with a money order.

The next City Council meeting will be held on Thursday, May 16, 2019 at 6:00 pm in the council chambers. Our Regular City Council meetings are usually held on the third Thursday of each month at 6:00 pm. The City Council and I would like to invite you to attend.
