The City Council and I met on December 19, 2019 for a Regular Meeting at 6:00 p.m. to discuss and approve the following items: 1. Appointed Interim City Marshal, Lawrence Robles, as the new City Marshal for Smiley. 2. Approved Tax Roll for 2019-2020. 3. Approved new water/sewer services for Mrs. Rodriguez on Bundick St. 4. Approved a new fire truck for the fire department and authorized Mayor to make negotiations with a bank. 5. Approved to add bonuses to the annual City budget.

We are waiting for TCEQ approval for the ww permit.
