Dear Citizens of Smiley,

City Hall will continue allowing one person at a time in the lobby. Please wait outside until you are instructed to come in. Please wear your face coverings when you enter into the city buildings. The Texas Governor has issued a new order GA-29 that requires face coverings in commercial entity or other building or space open to the public, or when in an outdoor public space, wherever it is not feasible to maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household; provided, however, that this face-covering requirement does not apply to the following: (please see executive order GA-29) It has been shared to the city Facebook page/City website. Our first priority is keeping everyone in the City of Smiley safe. We will get through this one day at a time, one step at a time, one prayer at a time but most importantly...by working together.
