PERMITS-Before you bring in a mobile home, RV, construct a new building or add on to an existing building a PERMIT application must be filed at City Hall, approved and paid for.

Permit applications \$25.00

City Permit \$100.00

No Peddling or Soliciting is allowed within the City Limits without a Permit. Permits can be purchased at City Hall.

TCEQ Requirement: 1-METER PER DWELLING (residential, Commercial, & industrial service connection)!

Yards along Highway 87 and 108 need to be cleaned Per City Ordinance

Animal Citation Fees for pickup/loose dogs \$25 and \$10 a day. Proof of Rabies shot record needs to be provided before they can be released.
